This document defines governance notes for DigiEmu Core 2.0 Draft 1. It describes release stewardship, traceability expectations, source-of-truth boundaries, and public standard publication discipline for partner-testable draft artifacts.

1. Purpose

The Governance Notes define how DigiEmu Core 2.0 Draft 1 artifacts SHALL be maintained, referenced, and communicated during public draft review and partner testing.

2. Source of Truth

The DigiEmu Core repository SHALL remain the normative technical source of truth. Public PDF documents MAY provide stable review copies, but GitHub release artifacts, tags, schemas, examples, and source documents govern technical interpretation.

3. Release Anchoring

Release artifacts SHOULD remain anchored to explicit tags, documented changelogs, reproducible examples, and verification fixtures. Major semantic changes SHALL be reflected in the release line and public documentation.

4. Draft Status

Core 2.0 Draft 1 is a public draft review and partner-testable milestone. It SHALL NOT be represented as a final certification standard until release governance explicitly marks it as stable.

5. Change Control

Changes to canonicalization, snapshot structure, verification output, or conformance requirements SHALL be traceable and documented. Breaking changes SHOULD include migration notes or compatibility statements.

6. Governance Responsibilities

Area	Governance expectation
Core repository	Maintains normative technical source artifacts.
Public standard site	Publishes stable public review copies and navigation.
PDF bundle	Provides review-friendly archival documents.
Demo artifacts	Provide reproducible examples for public validation.

9. Normative Keywords

MUST - absolute requirement.

SHOULD - recommended behavior.
